John A. Drake House (Pictured on the front cover.)

John Adams Drake, descendent of Sir Francis Drake, born in 1802, founded the town of Drakeville in 1846. An "S" was later added to make it Drakesville.

John established a general store, milling business and packing plant. The packing plant was the forerunner of Armour & Co. Later he engaged in the banking business and opened the Drakesville Bank. He built the brick home where the late Basil and Betty Swaim's home now stands in Drakesville. John died at 78 years of age in 1880 in Centerville.

John's wife's maiden name was Harriet Jane O'Neal, born in North Carolina. They had two sons. John Hamilton Drake, born in Drakesville, was a banker in Albia. He was killed in the Civil War. Francis Marion Drake was a brigadier general in the Civil War. He was a lawyer and banker in Centerville. Drake University was named for him. In 1895, he was elected Govenor of Iowa.







DRAKESVILLE HOTEL

A Drakesville landmark for over 110 years was the old hotel, which was located on the north side of the town oblong. The hotel (pictured above about 1910) was constructed in the late 1850's and according to the 1860 Census, Ohio native Isaac Routh was the hotel keeper.

The hotel provided separate lodging for men and women, which was typical for this period. The accommodations were accessible by two separate sets of stairs - one for men and one for women.

With no heating upstairs, the rooms were cold in the winter. The downstairs office provided the warmest place for guests and locals to loaf about. In addition to the salesmen and travelers who arrived by train, area farmers would often stay overnight when they brought their wheat or corn to the local mill for grinding.

Around 1920, Frank and Ada Munn purchased the building. The Munn's discountinued running a hotel and began selling automotive products out of the front office. They started making candy in the old hotel before moving that enterprise to an adjacent house (also visible in photo), which they named the Candy Kitchen.

About 1921, a brick structure was built behind the former hotel to house Drakesville's light plant that provided electricity for the town until rural electrification arrived in the 1930's. While this brick building is still standing, the old hotel and Candy Kitchen were taken down in 1970.

History of the Drakesville Lumber Company

Drakesville Lumber Co. was owned by John Wormhoudt. Curt Ross was the Manager, then later became a partner. There was a John Deere dealership as well, and it was owned by Wormhoudt and Ross. Rex Simmons returned home from the Navy in 1946 and became the bookkeeper and salesman. He applied for GI bill funds and that money somehow reimbursed the lumber yard for his salary. Other employees at that time included John Shepherd, Eddie Thompson, Cliff Foster, Walter Foster and Asher Hougland.

The Drakesville Lumber was located in the white building at the SE end of the oval. There was a big display glass in the west side to show off their wares. To the west (where the little red building sits) was the machinery repair shop (much bigger) and then to the west of that was the actual lumber yard. Here the actual lumber was stored in buildings that went almost to the Jones Produce building.

In 1953, Rex went to Denniston & Partridge Lumber in Bloomfield to be the Manager (it was located off the N.W. corner of the square). After the closing of Denniston Partridge, he became an employee of the Eclipse Lumber in Bloomfield (located across from Boone Body Shop). The Eclipse Lumber Co. wanted Simmons to move to Northern Iowa to another Eclipse Lumber location as manager, but he didn't want to leave the area.

Drakesville Lumber was still in business at this time. John Wormhoudt's interest in the business was being transferred to Wormhoudt Lumber (Henry & other Children). Henry Wormhoudt approached Simmons about buying his family's half interest in the business. Rex told him he didn't have the money to do that, but Wormhoudt told him that his sister did have the finances. So, she loaned Rex the money.

In August, 1956 Simmons and Ross moved the lumber business to Bloomfield. They built the building across from the fairgrounds that we knew as Bloomfield Lumber. A small building at that location was used until the new one was finished. At the same time, the John Deere dealership was sold to Earl Mikels and moved to Bloomfield.

While living in Drakesville, Rex, Lorraine and family lived in what would have been the John Lanferman (in the next block south of the Lumber bldg.) home and then later to the south of City Hall (known as the Gray property). To the east of the Lumber Yard building in the 2nd house (at that time) lived Rex's parents - Marion and Ohio Simmons. There was another home beside the lumber yard where Rex's brother, Max and Lorene Simmons (it is no longer there) lived with their family.

Rex, now 96 years of age and his wife Lorraine, now 92, still reside in their own home in Bloomfield.

The Governing Body of the Davis County Old Soldiers & Settlers Reunion Corporation of Drakesville, Iowa shall consist of four officers and three directors. Said Officers shall be duly elected (President, Vice President, Secretary & Treasurer) residents of Davis County, Iowa. Election to take place the 3rd Tuesday of September at 7:00pm at the Park Shelterhouse (unless otherwise published or posted.) The current officers shall choose three directors from past officers to complete the Governing Body. Officers and Directors shall serve a term of one calendar year or until qualified successors are elected. (amended 9/2015)

ARTICLE ONE

Committees:

There shall be no less than three (3) parties serving on any one committee.

The committee chairman shall be appointed by the Governing Body at a special meeting, following the election.

Committees shall work in conjunction with the Governing Body.

There shall be no less than twelve (12) committees.

ARTICLE TWO

Finances:

The Treasurer shall not issue any warrants or dispose of any money, credits or property belonging to the Old Soldiers & Settlers Corporation without consent of the Governing Body.

All properties, money and credits acquired by the Committees and Officers of the Corporation shall be filed and paid to the Treasurer.

All Officials and Committee members, with the exception of the police, shall receive no compensation or reimbursement for services rendered on behalf of the Old Soldiers and Settlers Corporation of Drakesville, Iowa.

All police shall receive the sum of \$25.00 per day for time actually served as police, with the exception of night watchman whose salary is to be determined by the Governing Body.

ARTICLE THREE

The purpose of this Corporation is for entertainment and enjoyment solely-no political party or any organization of any kind shall be permitted to take part on any program.

Ticket sellers on all rides shall receive two dollars (2.00) per hour.

The public address operator for all performances shall receive fifteen dollars (15.00) for the entire Reunion.

ARTICLE FOUR

Displays:

The Governing Body shall have the privilege of selling display plots to have a ten (10) foot frontage and twelve (12) feet in depth at the rate of \$10.00 per day per plot.

There will be a charge of ten dollars (\$10.00) fee per booth (eight by eight feet) 8x8 per day for space within the green building.

The Governing Body reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications for display plots and may take alterations concerning locations and adjustments thereof. The Governing Body reserves the right to reject any merchandise sold in the flea markets.

ARTICLE FIVE

Premiums:

The Treasurer and Governing Body shall have the jurisdiction of all premiums given as prizes.

ARTICLE SIX

Amendments:

Amendments to these Articles may be made at any annual meeting of the members or at any special meeting of the members called for that particular purpose, by the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members present and voting.

ARTICLE SEVEN

Parking:

All vehicles (including campers) will be parked where designated by police with the Governing Body having final authority. The Governing Body shall reserve the right to accept or reject any vehicles (including campers) on the grounds.

All campers, tents or otherwise, shall pay a fee of \$10.00/night.

ARTICLE EIGHT

Chairs:

An individual registering for the chair given to the Oldest Soldier and the Oldest Settler can only win a chair one year as the Oldest Soldier and one year as the Oldest Settler, but not in the same year. This amendment shall override any previous chair rules.

The individual registering must register in person the day of the Reunion and must be present to accept the chair. The decision reached by the Committee as to the winner will be determined by the age of the Oldest Soldier attending the Reunion who is now a resident of Davis County and has been constantly for the most years.

The Oldest Settler chair will be presented to the one attending the Reunion who is now a resident of Davis County and has been constantly for the most years. The individual must also register in person and be present to accept the chair.

ARTICLE NINE

Anyone having the Shelter House as a food stand has exclusive rights to all food on the grounds with the exception of the Carnival and the Old Settlers Corporation.

ARTICLE TEN

Prizes donated by merchants for the drawings will be given to only immediate members residing in the same household. They must be present and come forward to claim their prize at that time. Anyone who is donating their time working for the Reunion Corporation that particular evening and leaving his or her name with the Membership Committee or a Reunion officer are exempt and will get their prize. This does not apply to the prizes given by the Reunion Corporation each evening. You do not have to present to win them.

There is to be only one name per ticket.


